Call to order – 8:44 AM

Approval of previous minutes from Cathy approved – Erika Second

President Report – Tara Fergusson, President

- Met with Mustang Fund for small committee
 - Would like to raise the ask to \$750 per child, if half families gave \$750 it would be \$112, 500 making a decent difference in the outcome
 - Last year about 40% families gave, all in different amounts
 - Fund would launch potentially at the end of September, Pledge Day November 4th,
 - Levels 0-\$750 hand written thank you, \$5,000 or above tickets to gala (2), \$10k (2) gala tickets & a special dinner (not per kid but total), anyone that gives gets a thank you note, if you give \$750 per child you get to come to the Nature Lab for breakfast
 - Volunteer thank you on a different day
 - Push to get the flier out earlier than September 30^{th,} if possible, but big push will still go out November 4th
 - Payment plan will be communicated as well
 - o After campaign ends, we will do the breakfast and the dinner
 - Mustang Fund all approved

 - Graph will be going on the flier
 - Use percentage of the larger numbers
 - Remove Fundraising Events on the graph as it is covered by the actual event and we don't want to make it seem as though we are spending money on the events that is not covered

- Survey Results
 - Around 118 responses, was low for the year, 78% of the responders gave to the annual fund
 - Asked for seminars for parents, socials for families, having a middle school, have after school activities
 - Apples to zucchini are coming to the Nature Lab
 - All school field day, working with the bucket brigade, working with other schools that need more help outside Montecito
 - Form a MUS Group to get involved int eh Montecito Beautification Day, involved with the Safe Route to School with the Bucket Brigade
 - If a parent has a good idea for something to come to school, then bring it to Tara, Nick or Anthony
 - 93% people feel that they can volunteer with MUSF
